




Sheffield has excellent rail links to major UK cities and airports. We can arrange an airport transfer for you. You can be in Leeds or Manchester by train in about an hour and London in just over 2 hours. York, Nottingham, Liverpool and Birmingham are within easy reach by train or coach. The city has an excellent transport network with frequent buses and trams.



Students' Union


