People in the Newcastle area are called Geordies and they are known for their kindness and their dialect.

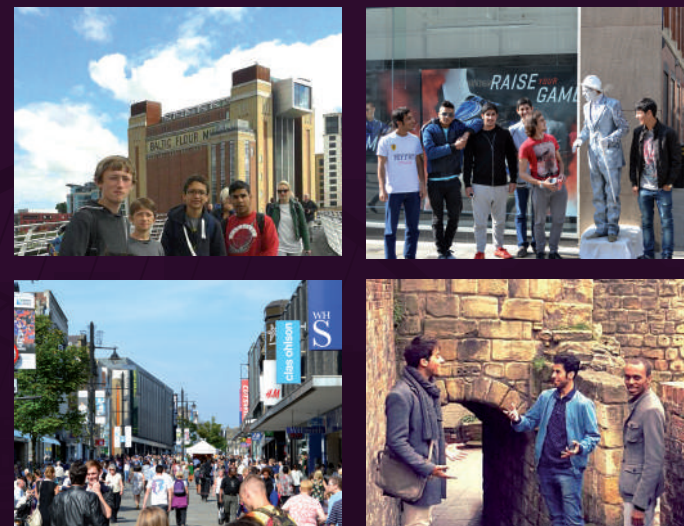


EXPERIENCE NEWCASTLE

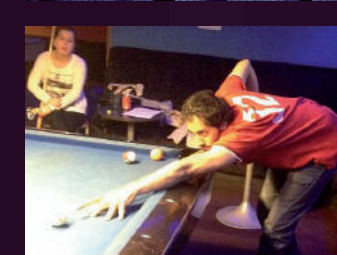
