Why Plymouth?

Plymouth combines the old with the new. In 1620 the Pilgrim Fathers chose Plymouth as the starting point of their historic voyage to Massachusetts, North America in a ship called "The Mayflower".

Now, Plymouth is a modern city of 275,000 inhabitants offering a wide range of shops, pubs, restaurants, theatres, sports facilities, etc. The surrounding countryside of Dartmoor and Cornwall is some of the most spectacular and naturally beautiful in Britain.

It is of no surprise that Plymouth has been voted "*Britain's Most Desirable City*".

Plymouth's size means that it has a great deal to offer while managing to avoid many of the social problems found in some of England's larger cities. In addition, there are very few language schools in Plymouth. This means that unlike Bournemouth, Brighton, London, Oxford, Cambridge, etc. there are not find many other foreign students in Plymouth. Consequently students have far more opportunity to speak English and far less temptation to speak their own language.

Aviation English

Teachers of English

The Mayflower College has been successfully running courses for teachers of English since 1991. Many of the European teachers who take these courses receive funding under the EU Lifelong Learning Programme (Comenius / Socrates).

- Using technology, music & drama in the EFL Classroom - 2 weeks

Accommodation
