



English for **Exam Success**

IELTS PREPARATION COURSE

(ALL UK LOCATIONS)

This course has 28 lessons per week which include Special Interest Groups in IELTS preparation. It develops your general language skills while also providing specialist preparation for the IELTS exam.



TOEFL IBT PREPARATION (ALL US LOCATIONS)
