General English Course

This is the course for most people. When you arrive we give you a short test and you will join a class that's right for your level.

- Start any Monday and stay as many weeks as you like
- Study for 15 or 25 hours a week
- All levels from Elementary to Advanced (A1-C2) CEFR

Teaching...

All teachers have internationally recognised qualifications in teaching English to non-English speakers. All are also committed Christians.

Classes are small, never more than 14 students; often there are fewer. Everybody can easily take part in the lessons. Most students are adults and all classes are multilingual. You must be 16 years or older to study at Olivet.

Lessons focus on the students' needs, interests and aims. Students learn by using the language through conversation, discussion, role-play, pair work, games, videos/DVDs, CDs and books. There are regular progress tests and ongoing assessments. Students have the opportunity to meet regularly with their teachers. Lessons are interesting; learning is fun!



The School Day...

- We teach each day Monday to Friday.
- The day begins with a short time of Christian worship; everyone is welcome but it's optional, you don't have to come.
- A full time course is 15 hours tuition per week. 3 hours each morning.
- An intensive course is 25 hours tuition per week; 3 hours in the morning and 2 hours in the afternoon.
- After lessons you may stay in school to do your homework, use the computers or chat with friends.

Accommodation...

Living in a homestay is a great way to practise your English and experience the English way of life. Most hosts live in the residential areas of the city and you take a short bus ride to the school. The bus stops outside Olivet. All hosts are carefully selected, visited and monitored by us, most of them are Christians. You have your own study/bedroom and you can have, meals with the family or buy and cook your own food (self-catering).

Olivet Student House is near the city centre and only 2 minutes walk from the school. You share the house with other Olivet Students. There are 6 study-bedrooms. You have your own room and share the kitchen, lounge and bathrooms with the others in the house. You buy and cook your own food and keep the house clean.





Examination Preparation Course

The Cambridge examinations for speakers of other languages are recognised internationally as a measure of your ability to attain and communicate at a competent level in English.

- **Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE)** - for learners at a Higher Intermediate (B1+) level.
- **Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)** - for learners at an Upper Intermediate/Advanced (B2 - C1) level.
- **Cambridge IELTS** - for learners currently studying at an Intermediate (B1) level and above.

IELTS is often required for entry into Higher Education (Colleges and Universities)
The exam tests your ability to use academic English for further study in English speaking countries.

The morning programme (15 hours per week) teaches the Grammar, Vocabulary and General skills required to take the exam.

The afternoon programme (10 hours per week) focuses on the examination questions and teaches the techniques and strategies required to pass the exam.

Love Brighton

The city by the sea!

Brighton is on the south coast of England, just 30 minutes from London Gatwick airport and less than an hour from central London. Olivet is in the centre of the city with classrooms overlooking the sea. It takes about 3 minutes to walk to the beach and 5 minutes to the shopping centre.

Once a small fishing village, Brighton grew quickly between 1750 and 1850, when the Prince Regent (later King George IV) came to live here. You must visit the Royal Pavilion, a fantastic seaside palace with Indian domes and a Chinese style interior.

Now it's a lively, cosmopolitan city. A centre for music, art, education, entertainment, tourism, business and much more. You may see one of the famous stars from TV or film who live here.

The city is surrounded by the beautiful South Downs. You will find peace and quiet as you walk up and down the gentle hills with wonderful views of the English countryside and the sea. You may like to stop for an English cream tea or a drink in an old English pub.

Social Activities

Every weekend there is an opportunity to join students from other schools in the Brighton area on an excursion to Oxford, London or some other famous place. These excursions cost extra.



There's plenty to do in and around Brighton: sports, music, cinema, theatre, pubs, clubs, museums, historic buildings, beautiful countryside and picturesque old villages. Sometimes students organise a visit or an evening out and invite all the other students to join them.

Several evenings each week students can join activities organised by local churches, such as an International Student cafe, sports events or Bible study groups.
